ACTUAL: This compares income vs. expenses. We'd like to fund everything according to budget, but we try not to spend what we haven't received yet.

REBIRTH 21: This loan was for repairs and renovations such as the kitchen, the ramp, and the sanctuary sound system. Donations to repay this loan are separate from church budget giving. Our outstanding balance is \$184,609.76.

REMEMBER: Tithe, though doing a vital work, all goes to our local Conference and does not cover any of our expenses. Those come out of Church Budget. So let's make the Church Budget as regular a part of our giving as tithe. We believe God will bless us for it.

BLACK HISTORY MUSIC SPOTLIGHT

Moses Hogan was an American composer, largely known for his choral music. He was a pianist, conductor, and world-renowned arranger. He published 88 arrangements for choir and voice during his lifetime. Hogan grew up in the church and was heavily involved with church music. His entire family was involved as choir singers, organists, pianists, and ministers of music. Hogan studied piano on a full scholarship at Oberlin Conservatory of Music. Following graduation he began studies at Julliard but did not complete them, and instead went on to study music in Vienna. He won first place at the 28th annual Kosciuszko Foundation Chopin Competition in NY. Hogan's music has shaped the choral world and brought back to life the Negro spiritual tradition.
