**REBIRTH 21:** This loan was for repairs and renovations such as the kitchen, the ramp, and the sanctuary sound system. Donations to repay this loan are separate from church budget giving. Our outstanding balance is \$184,609.76.

**REMEMBER:** Tithe, though doing a vital work, all goes to our local Conference and does not cover any of our expenses. Those come out of Church Budget. So let's make the Church Budget as regular a part of our giving as tithe. We believe God will bless us for it.

# Women's History Spotlight

French composer and harpsichordist Elizabeth Jacquet de La Guerre lived from 1665–1729. She was born into a family of musicians and harpsichord builders. de La Guerre's father and grandfather taught her about music and about the instrument business. When she was five, she was noticed by Louis XIV, the Sun King, who eventually invited her to become a musician of the court. When she was of age, she joined the court and received formal education and court training. She eventually left court and married an organist. During her marriage she continued to teach, compose, and give concerts throughout Paris. She was known for her great improvisation skill, and her keyboard music was widely known and celebrated during her life.

Gloria Gaither is a beloved icon in the Christian music world. Together with her husband, they have written over 700 songs. Gloria was born in Battle Creek Michigan and was the daughter of a pastor. In College she triple-majored in English, French, and Sociology, and later went on to earn a Master of Arts degree in British and American Literature. Gloria's first job out of college was as a high school French teacher. She met her husband during her time as a French teacher and they began to write songs recreationally. Gloria has since earned seven honorary doctorate degrees and written over 40 books, 20 of which are children's books.
