

REMEMBER: Our 2023 tithe was \$1,026,168. Tithe, although vital, goes to our local Conference and doesn't cover any of our expenses. Those come out of Church Budget. Let's make the Church Budget as regular a part of our giving as tithe. God will bless us for it.

It covers church expenses such as heat, A/C, lights, Guide Magazine, Primary Treasure, Our Little Friend, cleaning, kitchen supplies, SLA financial support, Adventurers, Pathfinders, office staff, this bulletin, and much, much more.
