

BUDGET: Our 2023 church budget was \$417,456 to cover our ministries, SLA subsidy, building maintenance, and operating expenses.

ACTUAL: This compares income vs. expenses. We'd like to fund everything according to budget, but we try not to spend what we haven't received yet.

REMEMBER: Tithe, although vital, goes to our local Conference and doesn't cover **any** of our expenses. Those come out of Church Budget. Let's make the Church Budget as regular a part of our giving as tithe. God will bless us for it.



We thank God for your generosity in 2023. We carried a deficit each month. Thankfully, we ended with a much smaller one than expected, and had it not been for unforeseen expenses, we may have had a surplus. So, the good news is that we have a well working HVAC system and we have removed the mold from our building. To do this, we now have a loan of just under \$300,000 ... much less than it could have been. The 2024 budget is being crafted now and we foresee a year of wonderful and meaningful events.
