

BUDGET: Our 2023 church budget is \$417,450 to cover our ministries, SLA subsidy, building maintenance, and operating expenses.

ACTUAL: This compares income vs. expenses. We'd like to fund everything according to budget, but we try not to spend what we haven't received yet.

REMEMBER: Tithe, although vital, goes to our local Conference and doesn't cover any of our expenses. Those come out of Church Budget. So let's make the Church Budget as regular a part of our giving as tithe. We believe God will bless us for it.



We voted in business meeting to authorize borrowing up to \$425,000 to cover the HVAC upgrades and mold removal process. That work is moving forward quickly, and details on how to pay that loan down will be forthcoming. Our July local church budget receipts were healthy, and the tithe receipts were slightly higher than last year. Please continue to remember your stewardship planning in your prayers as we move forward into the second half of 2023.
