

BUDGET: Our 2024 church budget is \$425,000 to cover our ministries, SLA subsidy, building maintenance, and operating expenses.

*Includes restricted giving that offsets church budget expenses.

ACTUAL: This compares income vs. expenses. We'd like to fund everything according to budget, but we try not to spend what we haven't received yet.

REMEMBER: Our 2023 tithe was \$1,026,168. Tithe, although vital, goes to our local Conference and doesn't cover any of our expenses. Those come out of Church Budget. Let's make the Church Budget as regular a part of our giving as tithe. God will bless us for it.



The church board received the March financial report at the April meeting. Our shortfall grew a bit, and we did incur an extra expense in March when we began fixing the problem with the sanctuary lights. (Please notice that nothing is hanging over the platform anymore.). This project is not complete yet since we do need more lighting in the sanctuary for evening programs. Please keep our local church budget in your stewardship planning. 
