

**BUDGET:** Our 2023 church budget is \$417,450 to cover our ministries, SLA subsidy, building maintenance, and operating expenses.

**ACTUAL:** This compares income vs. expenses. We'd like to fund everything according to budget, but we try not to spend what we haven't received yet.

**REMEMBER:** Tithe, although vital, goes to our local Conference and doesn't cover **any** of our expenses. Those come out of Church Budget. So let's make the Church Budget as regular a part of our giving as tithe. God will bless us for it.



What a year it has been! There have been highs and lows and a lot of work behind the scenes on our beautiful building. It's hard to comprehend, but between the HVAC project and the mold removal we spent \$718,203 in 2023. Thanks to many CC donations, SNEC subsidy, and some CC reserve funds, our loan amount will be \$298,500. Redemption is not good news if it only liberates us from bondage but doesn't bring us to God. Adoption is not good news if it only puts us in the Father' s family but not in his arms."


