

BUDGET: Our 2024 church budget is \$425,000 to cover our ministries, SLA subsidy, building maintenance, and operating expenses.

ACTUAL: This compares income vs. expenses. We'd like to fund everything according to budget, but we try not to spend what we haven't received yet.

REMEMBER: Our 2023 tithe was \$1,026,168. Tithe, although vital, goes to our local conference and *it does not cover any of our expenses*. Those come out of church budget. Let's make the church budget as regular a part of our giving as tithe. God will bless us for it.



Our deficit grew in May and June. This is an annual trend, partly due to the two weeks at camp meeting and the start of summer vacation. Let us prayerfully consider how we can help reduce our deficit so we can begin the fall on budget. We are very blessed by a generous church family, and we are thankful to see our HVAC loan balance decrease each month ... a special thank you to those who are chipping away at that project.





NOTES ON TODAY'S SPECIAL MUSICAL SELECTION

The composer of today's special musical selection is Ramón Serratos (1895–1973), who was a Mexican composer, pianist, and educator. At 11 years of age he was the organist in the parish of Compostela. At age 20 he graduated as "maestro de piano" in the Teatro Degollado de Guadalajara, which was an unprecedented event, considering that it was the first degree that the state government of Jalisco had ever granted in this subject. He was Director of the National School of Music of UNAM, the National Autonomous University of Mexico. This Nocturno has similarities of mood to a Chopin Nocturne, but also a nostalgic and poignant quality which is decidedly Mexican.
