Biography

Robert Farley '65 – Bob continued his studies at AUC after graduating from SLA in '65. He graduated from AUC with a Theology Major, and continued further studies at Andrews Theological Seminary, receiving an MDiv in '71. He returned to New England to pastor four churches in Keen, Brattleboro, Bellows Falls and West Townsend. His next challenge was to open a church in Berlin, NH, which became the first church between central New Hampshire and the Canadian border. His next position was in Syracuse, NY serving as the Youth, Temperance and Religious Liberty Leader, followed by the same position in the Southern New England Conference. Next, he was pastor of Manchester, Nashua and Merrimac, NH followed by a return to his roots in Maine, as pastor of Farmingdale, Augusta, Bath, Limington and Cliff Island. Bob retired seven years ago, but returned to Pastor the Augusta church.

Bob lives in Norridgewock on his family farm. He and his wife Cheri Buchholz Sabol, who is an RN have five children and eleven grand children in their blended family. Bob has two daughters, Amy Quatrano and Sarah Edmond. Cheri has two sons, Ryan and Gary Sabol, and one daughter, Amanda Sabol Schlifner.

Bob and Cheri enjoy gardening and the chores of the farm, as well as walks, reading, and an occasional auction as well as the peace and tranquility of their farm with the views of spectacular sun rises and sunsets.
