

BUDGET: Our 2023 church budget is \$417,450 to cover our ministries, SLA subsidy, building maintenance, and operating expenses.

ACTUAL: This compares income vs. expenses. We'd like to fund everything according to budget, but we try not to spend what we haven't received yet.

REMEMBER: Tithe, although vital, goes to our local Conference and doesn't cover **any** of our expenses. Those come out of Church Budget. So let's make the Church Budget as regular a part of our giving as tithe. God will bless us for it.



What a year it has been! There have been highs and lows and a lot of work behind the scenes on our beautiful building. It's hard to comprehend, but between the HVAC project and the mold removal we spent \$718,203 in 2023. Thanks to many CC donations, SNEC subsidy, and some CC reserve funds, our loan amount will be \$298,500. 
