COMPOSER SPOTLIGHT

English composer and conductor Samuel Coleridge-Taylor began his musical life as a violinist. He began studying at the age of 15 at the Royal College of Music. Taylor changed his focus from violin to composition, and following graduation he was appointed as a professor at the Crystal Palace school of music. His music became widely popular in England and the United States, and he toured the states three times. On his first tour, Taylor was received by President Roosevelt at the White House, a rarity for an African-American man at that time. He wanted to incorporate traditional African music into classical music, much like Brahms and Hungarian music, and Dvorak with Bohemian music. Taylor died at 37, but he left behind a large catalogue of works that continue to be popular today.
