

BUDGET: Our 2023 church budget is \$417,450 to cover our ministries, SLA subsidy, building maintenance, and operating expenses.

ACTUAL: This compares income vs. expenses. We'd like to fund everything according to budget, but we try not to spend what we haven't received yet.

REMEMBER: Tithe, although vital, goes to our local Conference and doesn't cover any of our expenses. Those come out of Church Budget. So let's make the Church Budget as regular a part of our giving as tithe. We believe God will bless us for it.



As you can see, we fell a bit behind in our budget, but it's not surprising since June involves Camp Meeting and we are away two out of four Sabbaths. While the expenses keep on (SLA, SS supplies, insurance, etc.), one silver lining is that utilities were down significantly because we're not running the AC. Let's keep the needs of our active church in our stewardship planning.
